RESOLUTION OF THE UNION COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NO. 3 TO THE CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW UNION COUNTY FAMILY COURTHOUSE BUILDING AT CHERRY STREET, ELIZABETH, NEW JERSEY.

WHEREAS, the Union County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") has been created by resolution of the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Union as a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, pursuant to and in accordance with the County Improvement Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:37A-44 et seq., and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has entered into a Shared Services Agreement dated November 1, 2011 with the County of Union (the "County"), pursuant to the Uniformed Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, et seq., in which the County has requested that the Authority assist it with the design, financing, management and construction of a new Family Court Building and Parking Deck for the Superior Court, County of Union (the "Project") in Elizabeth, New Jersey, and the Authority has agreed to undertake all actions necessary to implement the Project; and

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2013, the Authority awarded a contract for the construction of the new Union County Family Court Building to APS Contracting Inc. (the "Contract") as the lowest responsible bidder, exclusive of the deduct alternate, in the amount of \$33,380,000.00, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Contract, Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland, and Zurich American Insurance Company ("Surety") issued a Performance/Payment/Warranty Bond, identified as Bond No. PRF8359373, dated June 24, 2013, on behalf of APS in connection with the Project (the "Bond"); and

WHEREAS, APS Contracting Inc. subsequently failed to perform in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, on or about April 30, 2015, the Executive Director terminated the Contract with APS in accordance with terms and conditions of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Authority subsequently executed a Takeover Agreement with the Surety for the completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Project now has a need for additional work in the amount of \$358,882.83 to complete the Project, as detailed in Change Order No. 003, attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the Work is necessary and reasonable for the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Union County Improvement Authority that Change Order No. 003 be and is hereby approved in the amount of \$358,882.83, subject to the availability of funds and subject further to issuance of a Notice to Proceed to commence the work upon certification of available funds, which Change Order will result in a new Contract sum of \$35,699,048.3; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall take effect immediately.



### Change Order #3 Narrative May 4, 2016

The following are brief narratives describing each of the Potential Change Orders (PCOs) that are included in Change Order #3 (Totaling \$358,882.83) for the Union County Courthouse Building project:

1) PCO 00001 – Revised Storm Water Piping – The original design for the storm water piping was approved by the Building Department during the design phase of the New Union County Courthouse. However, the design was changed by the Building Department after the project was awarded, and the change required additional RCP piping and manholes to the existing storm water piping layout. The RCP piping will run along Lyons Place, Rahway Ave., and Cherry Street. The storm water tie-in connection will be at the corner of Rahway Ave. and Cherry Street to an existing inlet.

The original cost submitted by the General Contractor was \$129,803.05, the negotiated and agreed to the amount was \$97,663.02.

2) PCO 00031 – Hand Dryers – The County of Union requested to change from paper towel dispensers and trash receptacles to automatic hand dryers throughout the building excluding the 6 Judges' Chambers.

The original cost submitted by the General Contractor was \$40,312.00, the negotiated and agreed to the amount was \$37,868.65.

3) PCO 00046 – Real Time System – The State IT and State Judiciary requested scope revisions to the Real Time System to each of the six (6) courtrooms. A typical courtroom with Real Time System will include a TV monitor, TV terminal boxes behind the TV monitor with lockable door, three (3) floor boxes for the Plaintiff, Podium, & Defendant Tables, as well as Data drops, Outlets, HDMI, and USB ports at the Judge's benches and Plaintiff, Podium, & Defendant Tables. The purpose of the Real Time System is to allow Judges to receive, process, and return information as the court session is in progress. This information can then be shared through the TV monitors for the Plaintiff, Defendant, and the public to see. The Real Time System Change Order was reviewed by the County IT, MAST, and Netta and collectively agreed with the scope of work and price.

The original cost submitted by the General Contractor was \$117,269.00, the negotiated and agreed to the amount was \$111,824.00.

4) PCO 00054 – CourtSmart System and Millwork – The State IT and State Judiciary requested scope revisions to the CourtSmart System to each of the six (6) courtrooms and two (2) Hearing Rooms. Furthermore, as per the courtroom mockup walkthrough on 2/6/2015, the State Judiciary requested additional millwork for all six (6) Judge's Benches, Jury Box at Room #362, and Witness Stand at Room #362. Netta incorporated all of the requested changes and issued Bulletin #5: Courtroom Mockup Revisions.

The CourtSmart System allows to record audio from all of the microphones and video from all of the cameras in the courtroom and in the Judge's Chambers when court is in session. A typical CourtSmart server is located within the courtroom equipment rack and ties into the 1<sup>st</sup> floor State Server Room #151. As for the millwork, the Witness Stand and Jury Box at Room #362 will be extended and the Judge's Benches (6 Total) will receive an open bookshelf with countertop. The CourtSmart System Change Order was reviewed by the County IT, MAST, and Netta and collectively agreed with the scope of work and price.

The original cost submitted by the General Contractor was \$61,464.71, the negotiated and agreed to the amount was \$58,361.83.

5) PCO 00070 – Bulletin #4: Dividing Room #318 – The County of Union requested a design change in that Room #318 be divided into two (2) rooms. One to be file room and one to be an office. The redesign changes for Room #318 were made by Netta Architects and approved by the County of Union.

The original cost submitted by the General Contractor was \$6,656.63. MAST and Netta have reviewed and find the cost to be reasonable at \$6,656.63.

6) PCO 00073 – Permanent Power – During a site walkthrough on 3/17/2015 with PSEG and the General Contractor, PSEG stated that the permanent power design needs to be modified to meet their requirements. PSEG requested to change from two (2) 4" conduits to two (2) 5" conduits and requested to add a manhole on Cherry Street for future maintenance service. The changes will allow PSEG to provide permanent power to the new Union County Courthouse Building.

The original cost submitted by the General Contractor was \$12,616.00, the negotiated and agreed to the amount was \$11,668.38.

7) PCO 00098 – UCIA Added Entry Door – The original design for the UCIA space was to be completely separated from the main Union County Courthouse Building with its own entrance. Since the Prosecutor will be occupying the UCIA space, the County of Union decided to add an entry door between Room #221 (UCIA space) and Room #223 (Main Building) which will allow the Prosecutors to have direct access to the main Union County Courthouse Building on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

The original cost submitted by the General Contractor was \$7,044.21, the negotiated and agreed to the amount was \$5,054.33.

8) PCO 00099 – Roof Access Hatch and Ladder to Room #288 – The County of Union requested the addition of a roof access hatch and ladder for the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor lower roof area.

The original cost submitted by the General Contractor was \$15,628.91, the negotiated and agreed to the amount was \$13,412.81.

9) PCO 00134 – Announcement System – As per the UCIA Judge's Meeting on 1/13/2016, the State Judiciary requested an "Announcement System" to be installed from each of the Judge's Chamber (6 Total) to their respective Courtroom. The Judges will activate the "Announcement System" at the push of a button to call the Sheriff so he/she can bring them to the courtroom. The tone of the "Announcement System" will be modified to meet the State Judiciary needs.

The original cost submitted by the General Contractor was \$16,373.18. MAST and Netta have reviewed and find the cost to be reasonable at \$16,373.18.



# RESOLUTION OF THE UNION COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY MAKING APPLICATION TO THE LOCAL FINANCE BOARD

WHEREAS, the Union County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") has been created by resolution of the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Union as a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey, pursuant to, and in accordance with the County Improvement Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:37A-44 et seq., and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to make application to the Local Finance Board, in the Division of Local Government Services, Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey (the "Local Finance Board"), pursuant to N.J.S.A.40A:5A-6 and N.J.S.A. 40:37A-80 and such other applicable statutes as applicable for the Local Finance Board's review for the proposed issuance of (i) lease revenue bonds to be issued to finance the funding of certain building improvements associated with the Park Madison courthouse project, and (ii) bonds to be issued to finance the funding of certain costs associated with the Verge redevelopment project, and any notes to be issued in anticipation of either series of bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Authority believes that: (a) it is in the public interest to accomplish such purpose; (b) said purpose or improvements are for the health, welfare, convenience or betterment of the inhabitants of the local unit or units; (c) the amounts to be expended for said purpose or improvements are not unreasonable or exorbitant; and (d) the proposal is an efficient and feasible means of providing services for the needs of the inhabitants of the local unit or units and will not create an undue financial burden to be placed upon the local unit or units;

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNION COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY as follows:

- **Section 1.** The Authority's application to the Local Finance Board is hereby authorized and approved, and the Authority's Bond Counsel, McManimon, Scotland & Baumann, LLC and other Authority professionals, along with other representatives of the Authority, are hereby authorized to prepare such application and to represent the Authority in all matters pertaining thereto.
- **Section 2.** The Secretary of the Authority is hereby directed to prepare and file a copy of the proposed resolution with the Local Finance Board as part of such application.
- **Section 3.** The Local Finance Board is hereby respectfully requested to consider such application and to record its findings and recommendations as provided by the applicable New Jersey Statute.
  - **Section 4.** This resolution shall take effect immediately.
